Day 1 ~ Monday, October 12, 2020

USA / En Route

Depart the United States flying overnight to **Israel**.

Day 2 ~ Tuesday, October 13, 2020

Tel Aviv / Galilee

Arrive Ben Gurion Airport in **Tel Aviv**, directly on the **Mediterranean Sea** and **Israel's largest city**. Meet, assist and begin the journey traveling up the Israeli coastline to **Caesarea**, the **Roman capital of Judea**. View the beautiful restored **Roman Theater**, the **ruins of the ancient town, harbor and aqueduct**. Onto **Mukhraka, Mount Carmel**, with spectacular views of Northern Israel, near the spot where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal. Continue across the Jezreel Valley to the **Galilee**.

*Tiberias (D)***Day 3 ~ Wednesday, October 14, 2020**

Galilee

Begin the day with a visit to the **ancient boat** at Kibbutz Ginnosar. Set sail on the beautiful **Sea of Galilee** with an inspirational time of **praise & worship**. Disembark at **Capernaum**, residence of Jesus during his ministry in the Galilee and the location of several of his miracles. Continue to **Tabgha**, the traditional site of the **miracle of loaves and fishes**. Next, visit the **Mount of Beatitudes**, site of the **Sermon on the Mount**. Then, proceed to a **border outpost to meet Israeli soldiers** who keep Israel safe along her northern border with Lebanon. Drive past the **Golan Heights**, site of the **former Syrian fortifications**. Onto **Caesarea Philippi**, located on the southwestern slope of Mount Hermon, where Peter made his great confession of faith. Visit **Mt. Bental**, an excellent lookout point towards **Syria in the east**, the **Hermon slopes in the north** and the **southern Golan Heights**.

*Tiberias (B,D)***Day 4 ~ Thursday, October 15, 2020**

Galilee / Jerusalem

Begin this morning being **Baptized** in the **Jordan River**, at the beautiful site of **Yardenit**. Drive and view **Nazareth**, the **boyhood home of Jesus**. Continue across the **Jezreel Valley** to **Megiddo**, one of **Solomon's chariot cities** and the **site of the coming battle of Armageddon**. Visit to Ancient **Shiloh**. Shiloh was one of the main centers of Israelite worship during the pre-monarchic period, by virtue of the presence there of the Tent Shrine and Ark of the Covenant. Continue your journey through the Judean Desert up to **Jerusalem**, with a **special blessing** atop **Mount Scopus** upon arrival.

*Jerusalem (B,D)***Day 5 ~ Friday, October 16, 2020**

Jerusalem

Morning visit to **Ir David, the City of David**, with an exciting journey both above and below ground through **excavations, fortresses and passageways**, walking through the **Canaanite tunnel**. Next, visit the **Davidson's Visitor Center** in the **Southern Wall Archaeological Garden**. Next, be one of the many volunteers who have participated in this incredible operation of the **Temple Mount Sifting Project** at **Emek Tzurim Park** where, so far, there have been over 3,500 finds from ancient times. Continue to **St. Peter in Gallicantu Church** overlooking the **Kidron Valley** and **Caiaphas' House**. Onto the walled Old City of Jerusalem through **Zion Gate** to the **Upper Room of the Last Supper**. Then, to the **Jewish Quarter of the Old City** that was reconstructed after the city was unified at the conclusion of the Six-Day War in 1967. A special point of interest in the restored Jewish Quarter is the **"Cardo"**, meaning the **"heart"** of this ancient Byzantine city. As the sun sets, gather at the **Western Wall (Kotel)** for the traditional bringing in of the **Sabbath**. Special **Shabbat dinner with host family**.

*Jerusalem (B,D)***Day 6 ~ Saturday, October 17, 2020**

Jerusalem / Judean Desert

Today's full day begins with a drive into the **Judean wilderness** for a visit to **Masada, the mountain top ruin of Herod's Palace and the last fortress of the Jewish revolt against Rome**. Visit the **Ein Gedi** region located on the shores of the Dead Sea. Embark on a journey between the valley, high rising cliffs and spectacular landscapes as far as the eye can see. Nakhal David and Nakhal Arugot flow year round through deep canyons surrounded by lush vegetation – a sharp contrast to the surrounding desert. See wildlife while walking through canyons and view the place where David took refuge from King Saul, followed by **floating in the unsinkable Dead Sea**. Return to **Jerusalem** after the day's adventure.

Day 7 ~ Sunday, October 18, 2020

Jerusalem

This morning, walk the **Western Wall Tunnels**, experiencing more than 2,000 years of history. Enjoy a panoramic view atop the **Mount of Olives**. Walk down **Palm Sunday Road** to the **Garden of Gethsemane**. In the Old City of Jerusalem, visit **St. Anne's Church** and the **Pool of Bethesda**, followed by a walk along the **Via Dolorosa**. Follow the **Stations of the Cross (Via Dolorosa)**, through narrow alleys and souks to the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**. Walk atop ancient pavement to the **Ecce Homo Archway**. Next, an unforgettable visit to the **Memorial to the Holocaust at Yad Vashem**.

Jerusalem (B,D)

Day 8 ~ Monday, October 19, 2020

Jerusalem / En Route

Take part in a **special communion service at the Garden Tomb**. Pass **Israel's Parliament Knesset** grounds en route to the **Shrine of the Book at the Israel Museum**, where the **Dead Sea Scrolls** are housed. View the **Model of Ancient Jerusalem**, a miniature of the city during the Second Temple period. Continue to **Bethlehem**, visiting **Shepherd's Field** and **Manger Square**. The touring program ends at the **Friends of Zion Museum** dedicated to the outstanding contributions of Christians to the State of Israel. Enjoy a special **Farewell Dinner** before **transferring to the airport** with assistance in departure for flight to the United States.
